Courses

More than 20 online courses are offered each year by Illinois IDEA. The titles appear in your university course listings with your university's course titles and numbers. To review and select courses, students can access information at the Illinois IDEA website such as syllabi, learning outcomes, books and assignments. www.illinoisideahs.org.

Registration

Students admitted to any one of the Alliance universities may enroll in Illinois IDEA HS courses without transferring or applying to another institution. An Alliance Campus Coordinator at each university assists you with registration. Names of Campus Coordinators are available on the Illinois IDEA website. You'll pay the usual tuition and fees to your home institution.

Course schedules, credit, and grades

Each university runs on a slightly different calendar, so Alliance courses may start at different times than at your home school. Your Campus Coordinator can connect you with your instructor and tell you about drop/add dates and other administrative details. Your grades and credit will be recorded on your transcript as usual.

Certificates

Alliance universities are developing online certificates in disaster preparation and emergency management for healthcare, cybersecurity, and other fields. These credentials enhance professional skills and employability.
